

DECLARATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE RESTRICTION OF HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES (RoHS) DIRECTIVE 2002/95/EC

Neopost is committed to compliance with the European Union Restriction of Hazardous Substances Directive and its further amendments (RoHS Directive) that will restrict the use of lead (Pb), mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium and two-bromine containing flame retardants : PBB (polybrominated biphenyls) and PBDE (polybrominated diphenil ethers) in electronic products.

The undersigned, being a duly authorised representative of Neopost Technologies BV, Neopost Industrie SA and Neopost International Supply Ltd hereby declares on behalf of these Companies that, on the basis of the declarations of compliance of their respective suppliers:

By July 1, 2006, all Neopost products delivered by the Neopost Group Supply Chain – Mailing and Document Systems- subject to the RoHS Directive and sold from this date will be free of substances restricted by the RoHS Directive or at levels compliant with the legal limits, except where there is no technically feasible alternative and where the presence of such substances in higher levels is authorized for specific applications (in accordance with exemptions under the EU RoHS Directive or national regulations).

This Initiative to address RoHS Directive requirements is part of the Neopost Group's Quality, Health, Safety and Environmental Policy which includes Waste reduction, Eco-Design on products and combined ISO 9001/140001/OHSAS 18001 certifications programs.
